**Part 2 – Last 6 Steps to Manga Creation**

<b>6 Steps</b>	<b>Legal Information</b>
<p><i>1. Page Set-up:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The printer tell you the dimentions for the bleed and crops they want</li><li>• Never more then 8 panels per page</li><li>• Do not over use 1 and 2 page spreads</li></ul> <p><i>2. Draw / Ink / Tone</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Computer software can make lines sharper and cleaner then by hand</li><li>• Three main steps<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>◦ Re-Sketching</li><li>◦ Inking</li><li>◦ Toning</li></ul></li></ul> <p><i>3. Text</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Lots of text can slow the pace of a scene down, while less text makes it faster</li><li>• Keep the text simple this is not a novel, the pictures should tell the story</li></ul> <p><i>4. The Cover</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Should reflect what the story is about</li><li>• Keep the title and other text at the same place on all volumes of your series</li><li>• Leave room on the back of the book for a bar code if you want to sell in a store</li></ul> <p><i>5. Publisher / Printer</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Publishers will take some creative control from you but in return allow you to use their name</li><li>• Self-publishing has up front costs but you will earn 100% of the profit</li></ul> <p><i>6. Legal Information</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Three key legalities to take care of<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>◦ ISBN</li><li>◦ Copyright</li><li>◦ Legal Deposit</li></ul></li></ul>	<p><i>Canadian ISBN Service System</i> <a href="http://www.collectionscanada.gc.ca/ciss-ssci/index-e.html?">http://www.collectionscanada.gc.ca/ciss-ssci/index-e.html?</a></p> <p><b>Warning!!</b> The website was integrated with the collections canada website, and is very hard to find.</p> <p>What is it:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Needed to sell a book in a store or online</li><li>• Does not cost anything to obtain a number</li></ul> <p><i>Copyright Info</i> <a href="http://www.cipo.ic.gc.ca/eic/site/cipointernet-internetopic.nsf/eng/h_wr00003.html">http://www.cipo.ic.gc.ca/eic/site/cipointernet-internetopic.nsf/eng/h_wr00003.html</a></p> <p>Fees:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Between \$50 and \$65 depending on how the form as submitted</li></ul> <p>How long does a copy right last:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Expires on the 31<sup>st</sup> of December 50 years after the Copyright holder dies</li><li>• Example: Dies August 23<sup>rd</sup> 2010 Copyright expires December 31<sup>st</sup> 2060</li></ul> <p><i>Legal Deposit</i> <a href="http://www.collectionscanada.gc.ca/legal-deposit/index-e.html">http://www.collectionscanada.gc.ca/legal-deposit/index-e.html</a></p> <p>What is it:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 2 copies to be gave when more then 100 books printed</li><li>• 1 copy to be gave if between 4 and 99 books are printed</li><li>• Federal Law states that all Canadian Publishers must do this</li></ul>
